RE: Korea Restriction of Hazardous Substances (RoHS)

Dear Customer

Ultra Electronics AEP is committed to the highest standards of manufacturing and environmental management.

The Restriction of the Use of Certain Hazardous Substances in Electrical and Electronic Equipment Regulations 2006, implementing the European Directive, came fully into force in the UK on 1st July 2006. These Regulations were replaced by "The Restriction of the Use of Certain Hazardous Substances in Electrical and Electronic Equipment Regulations 2008", (European RoHS Directive) which came into force in the European Union on 1st February 2008. A further revision of RoHS, RoHS 2 came into force in the UK on the 8th of June 2011.

Effective January 1, 2008, Korea implemented a regulation requiring manufacturers and importers of some electrical and electronic products to comply with maximum concentration values of six hazardous substances as well as meet recycling requirements.

The six hazardous substances are lead, mercury, cadmium, hexavalent chromium, PBB and PBD—the same substances and maximum concentration values as those regulated in the European RoHS Directive.

*Targeted products are televisions, refrigerators, washing machines, air conditioners, personal computers, mobile phones, printers, copiers and facsimile machines.
IT Networking products are not currently covered.*



Based on our understanding of the Korean RoHS/WEEE Directive, Ultra Electronics AEP products are not subject to the Korean RoHS/WEEE law at this time. If the Korean regulations are expanded in the future to include IT networking products, all currently supplied MegaBOX and MegaPAC equipment by our distributor, AEP-KoreaNet Inc. **are RoHS 2 compliant.**

Ultra Electronics AEP is obliged to comply with any future changes to the EU and UK RoHS/WEEE directives. In addition if Korean RoHS/WEEE Directives are different to the EU and UK directives, Ultra Electronics AEP will endeavour to comply with these.
